## Presidents Report – Charlotte Konkle

Thank you all for coming today and I would like to introduce Karen Gallant of Quinte Association - she is a newbie in tenpin bowling and is jumping in with both feet. I have to add that she did make some money at the provincial tournament in Niagara. Welcome Karen!

First of all I would like to discuss the changes in the committees for the next year or so - I didn't shake them all up just a few - we all get used to our roles in a volunteer organization and that is good but at the same time we need to move on to something else in order to keep our brains functioning and our association also. Besides I had to find a place for Karen, Tim and Randy for sure. I hope that you all agree with me and look forward to your new positions with enthusiasm.

This must be the year for change - you all are aware of the changes in CTF so far starting with the teleconference AGM on Nov. 15 at 9:00 am CST which I think is 11:00 am EST. I will be part of that conference call on behalf of OTBA. ## **Adult Committee Meeting – Della Trude**

Present: Charlotte Konkle, Della Trude, Karen Nicol, Alf Ferguson, Wayne Dubs, Jamie Morand, Donna Lloyd and Anne Marie Cole

The meeting was called to order at 12:17 p.m.

The tournament was discussed and Charlotte mentioned that some bowlers would like to see a Scratch Tournament held the same time as the Handicap Tournament. We would use the same format and charge the same fee. The Handicap Tournament entries and payout might be lower but we would benefit because more bowlers will go in the Scratch Tournament. Everyone agreed that we should try it for next year. Since it will be two separate tournaments, a bowler can win in both the Scratch and Handicap Tournament.

The tournament will be held at Rev's Rose Bowl in Windsor on May 16 & 17, 23 & 24 and 30 & 31, 2015. The entry fee will remain at \$30.00. The breakdown has to be shown on the entry form.

(Prize Fee - \$16.00, Bowling Fee - \$9.33, Expense Fee \$4.67, Total Fee \$30.00 Per Person Per Event)

The All Events fee for both Handicap & Scratch Tournament will be \$10.00. We discussed CTF Rule 319A(2) pertaining to the 10 pin improvement rule and agreed it should be left in the rules.

The committee agreed that no plaques will be given out for the 2015 OTBA Handicap and Scratch Tournaments. We will print 2000 Handicap Tournament entry forms (white paper) and 500 Scratch Tournament entry forms (yellow paper) and print 60 Posters.

We discussed the added money for the tournaments and agreed to add \$200.00 per event to the prize fund in the Handicap Tournament and \$50.00 per event in the Scratch Tournament.

The committee went over the entry forms and rules and made the required changes.

Wayne Dubs made a statement that it would be very nice if more associations would submit bids to host the adult annual provincial tournament.

## **Amalgamating the 3 organizations (OTBA, ON5PBA & BowlOntario) – Charlotte Konkle**

- We again have a new Consultant, Faye Blackwood.
- The Ministry of Sport has finally come along with all of us with the idea of one "umbrella" organization based on the model of the Bowling Federation of Canada.
- This umbrella organization is needed to get funding from the ministry.
  - Two critical points.
    - One organization is a business and two organizations are volunteers.
    - The other one is who will be on this organization. Because Bowl Ontario is splitting 5 pin and 10 pin (not yet done but maybe in the next couple of weeks) therefore the breakdown could be three from the Bowling Federation of Ontario, three from 5 Pin, three from 10 pin and three from Bowl Ontario.
  - Ontario 5 pin suggested a meeting to find out how we really are setup. A conference call will be setup to discuss this further.
  - Our consultant told us in the past that we do not need to be incorporated but we do. The cost of this is \$150.00 for the name check. Ontario 5pin sent a letter to use the name BOWLING FEDERATION ONTARIO. This was rejected as only the 5pin name was on the letter and not all three organizations.
  - For some reason the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Council name is still on file. Charlotte is waiting for a response from the ministry as to why. We may be able to use this name.
  - The funding cycle for 5pin and 10pin is coming up. This is done in three year cycles but they added a year because of this amalgamation.

- Della Trude made a motion, seconded by Jayne Picott that Bowlerama Royal be awarded the tournament for 2016. All in favour, Carried
- The board asked Karen Nicol if they would like to re-submit their bid for 2017. She stated she will have to take this back to her board.
- The next board meeting will be held on June 6, 2015 at 2pm. Location is still to be confirmed.
- The next AGM meeting will be held on June 7, 2015 at 10am. Location is still to be confirmed.
- The fall board meeting will be held on Oct 3, 2015 at 2pm. Location is still to be confirmed.
