1. Entrants must be a member of a CTF sanctioned youth league or bowl in a youth league and an adult league, and must have participated in at least two-thirds (2/3rds) of the youth schedule at the time of bowling in order to bowl in a CTF youth tournament. Exceptions are available to bowlers who are out of province due to an education commitment, provided they purchase a CTF membership and bowl for their province of residence. Achievement recognition will be provided as per CTF Playing Rules. For a complete review of CTF youth tournament eligibility, including situations not covered herein, refer to the CTF Playing Rulebook, rule 300d4.
2. This tournament is sanctioned by the Canadian Tenpin Federation and shall be governed by all CTF rules.
3. Entry closing date is **January 25, 2020**. Entries received after that date will only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

No tournament re-entries will be permitted.

7. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 240, for all bowlers.
8. Entry fees will be as follows:

9. Award fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded to youth/teen contestants only at a minimum of the first-place winner. No adult bowler competing in any division is eligible for scholarship awards.

The scholarship awards will be managed by the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Youth Committee. *Note:* CTF 319d will not apply as prizes are for youth bowlers only.

10. No electronic devices (headsets, phones, etc.) permitted to be used while participating in this event.



11. Athletes are not permitted to smoke, eat or consume alcoholic beverages while bowling in the tournament. If there is a medical reason that requires a bowler to eat or drink during the event, please bring it to the attention of the Tournament Director.
12. A bowler showing up late will be credited with zero for each frame missed.
13. Entrants must register 30 minutes prior to squad time.
14. The tournament will consist of a single four (4) game block. All games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
15. **CTF YOUTH AVERAGES:** Average closing date is December 28, 2019. Bowlers without a 9-game average as of that date must bowl scratch.

A standing sheet as of December 28, 2019 must accompany all entry forms to verify averages, for all leagues the bowler in which the bowler is active (including adult and sport leagues).

16. **ADULT AVERAGES:** If the adult bowler is sanctioned by the CTF they must use the higher of:
 - a. 2018/2019 yearbook average of 21 games or more
 - b. Current sanctioned league average as of December 28, 2019, with 21 games or more
 - c. Their highest unsanctioned average as defined below

Non-sanctioned adult bowlers or sanctioned bowlers with no yearbook average and fewer than 21 games will be allowed into the tournament with the payment of an additional \$5 CTF tournament participation fee. Their average will be calculated as follows:

- a. If they have bowled 21 games in an unsanctioned league they may submit a league recap sheet with all scores as of December 28, 2019 and use that as their average.
- b. If they qualified through a house round they may use the average of all games bowled during the house round qualification. A copy of the tournament results must be submitted for average verification.
- c. If they did not qualify through a house round they will be assigned an average of 169 for males and 138 for females, calculated as the mean average for male and female bowlers in Ontario during the 2018/2019 season.

Adults are responsible for verifying their own average, no matter who has submitted it. If the submitted average is lower than required by the above rules the bowler's scores will be disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, tournament scores will be based on the (higher) submitted average.

17. The order in which the bowlers are listed on the lane sheets will be the official bowling order. No changing of bowlers or rearranging the bowling order will be allowed at time of registration or bowling.
18. Any situations not covered by any of the aforementioned rules will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
