1. Entrants must be a member of a CTF sanctioned youth league or bowl in a youth league and an adult league, and must have participated in at least two-thirds (2/3rds) of the youth schedule at the time of bowling in order to bowl in a CTF youth tournament. Exceptions are available to bowlers who are out of province due to an education commitment, provided they purchase a CTF membership and bowl for their province of residence. Achievement recognition will be provided as per CTF Playing Rules. For a complete review of CTF youth tournament eligibility, including situations not covered herein, refer to the CTF Playing Rulebook, rule 300d4.
2. All CTF Tournament rules and regulations shall be enforced.
3. Entry closing date for Teams/Singles is **April 4, 2020**. Entry closing time for Doubles is **2 hours prior to squad time**. Entries received after close will only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

4. Squad times and dates are as follows:

The tournament will attempt to honour all time requests, however their decision will be final.

5. Tournament location:

6. Bowlers may enter the **Singles** event only once. Bowlers may enter the **TEAM** event multiple times provided that at least one (1) bowler is new to the team. Bowlers may enter the **Doubles** event multiple times provided that at least one(1) of the bowlers are new to the doubles team
7. **TEAM EVENTS** shall be made up of four (4) bowlers each and may comprise all boys, all girls, or any mixture. Divisions are determined by total team average.

8. **Singles EVENTS** divisions are separate for boys and girls, and determined by average.

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9. **Doubles EVENTS** shall be made up of two (2) bowlers in any combination of boys and girls. Divisions are determined by total team average. You can only enter **Doubles** if you have entered **Singles** or **Teams**.

10. **All-Events** (combined **Singles**, **Doubles**, and **Teams**) will be awarded. All bowlers participating in all three events are automatically eligible for **All-Events**. Bowlers' first appearances in each event will count towards **All-Events**.
11. Handicap to be calculated on 90% of the difference between the bowler's highest average and 240. This is based on a minimum of nine (9) games as of February 22, 2020. Members not having the required number of games in a youth league (9 games) must enter with a scratch average of 240.

13. Award fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in scholarships, with additional scholarship money awarded as available.

14. Scholarships for **All-Events** will be first place only.
15. Scholarships will be awarded for **Singles**, **Doubles** and **Teams** in a ratio of not less than 1 in 10 to a maximum of 4 places. Scholarship amounts will be determined on the amount of entries received.
16. If a bowler qualifies in first place in both singles handicap and singles scratch they will be awarded the handicap position only. Team and Double awards are handicap only.
17. Events will be comprised of three (3) games for each event in all classes. Each event will all be bowled on a single pair of lanes.
18. Co-Champions will be declared should there be a tie in either **Singles** or **Teams** or **Doubles** or **All-Events** in all classes.
19. A league standing sheet as of February 22, 2020 must be submitted with entry showing pinfall, number of games bowled, and highest league average. If a bowler bowls in more than one league all average sheets are to be submitted including all adult and sport league averages. Once the entry has been submitted and verified no changes will be made except for substitutions. **Do not send individual record sheets!**



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**RULES**

20. Tournament entry money is not refundable for any entries that have been received and processed.
21. Early bird payments that have been received are not considered a complete and valid entry until all paper work is also received. Therefore, you **must** complete, sign, verify and mail the entry forms, and league standing sheet by Midnight March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 before the entry is eligible for the early-bird price.
22. Single entries after the deadline may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
23. Entry forms that miss the early bird date (above) are considered regular entries and are subject to a different cost. You **must** complete, sign, verify and mail these entry forms, league standing sheet by Midnight April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Failure to do this will be cause for your entry fee to be forfeited. Any pre-payment without documentation is NOT considered a complete entry.
24. Each entry will be notified of acceptance by confirmation of date and time bowling.
25. Athletes are not permitted to smoke, eat or consume alcoholic beverages while bowling in the tournament. If there is a medical reason that requires a bowler to eat or drink during the event, please bring it to the attention of the Tournament Director.
26. Bowlers will be required to provide their own bowling shoes. A limited number of shoes will be available from the front counter.
27. Coaches must register at the lanes one full hour prior to their **Singles** or **Teams** scheduled time of bowling prior to which any changes required must be made.
28. A bowler showing up late will be credited with zero for each frame missed.
29. Any protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the completion of the tournament.
30. Any changes to entries sent to the Tournament Director must include pinfall, games bowled, and league standing sheet as of February 22, 2020.
31. Proper attire is required. Shirts must have sleeves and be free of obscene graphics or lettering etc. Jeans, pants, shorts, skirts must not have any noticeable holes. No hats, music players, track pants, pyjama pants, or halter tops are to be worn. No electronic devices (headsets, cell phones, etc.) permitted while competing in this event. The Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not wearing suitable attire after reasonable opportunity to change has been given.
32. The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust a bowler's average before participating in any event providing sufficient documentation can be produced.
33. The tournament manager reserves the right to cancel or reschedule squads as required.
34. Results will be posted on the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association youth web page <http://www.otba.ca>.
35. Any situations not covered by the rules will be at the Tournament Director's discretion.
